




# **Ask for Easy Read**

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## What is Easy Read?

Sometimes information is hard to read. This can be because:



• The words are too hard.



• The text is too small.



• There is too much information.



Easy Read is information written to be easier to understand.

Easy Read can help everyone, but it is most useful for people who:



• Have trouble reading.

# Why is Easy Read important?



The law says you have a right to information that you can understand.

#### When you understand information, it helps you:



• live an independent life



• make your own choices



• have your say



• get involved in your community.

# What makes Easy Read easier?

Easy Read:

• Uses simple words as much as possible.

• Explains hard words.



• Uses short sentences.



• Includes pictures to help explain ideas.





• Breaks information into smaller parts.



• Uses large font size.



• Leaves space, so the page is not too full.



This is what you are asking for when you ask for Easy Read.



# How to ask for Easy Read



If information is hard to read or understand, you can ask for Easy Read. To ask for Easy Read:



• Contact the organisation or service. By phone, email, or in person.



• Tell them their information is hard for you to read.



• Ask for the information in Easy Read.



• Tell them what information you need.



• Ask when you will get it.

## Where to ask for Easy Read

You can ask for Easy Read from places like:



• Your doctor or hospital.



• The council.



• Housing associations.



• Your bank.



• Support services.



• Electric, gas, or water companies.



• Police or fire services.



• Libraries.
