Well-being and Learning Disability Programme



In the West Glamorgan region, people with a learning disability have the right support to make their own choices to achieve a happy, healthy life that is meaningful to them. They have opportunities to learn, work and actively contribute to their communities

Learning Disability Strategy 2024 - 2029



- The Board wanted a strategy for adults with learning disabilities
 The strategy will last 5 years
- To write the strategy we wanted to know what is important to people with learning disabilities



- Your Voice Advocacy talked to people with learning disabilities for 3 months
- They also spoke with carers and staff during this time
- People shared their thoughts and feelings at these events

May Your Voice Be With You Event



- We had another event for people with learning disabilities, carers and staff
- We wanted to learn more about the important topics found by Your Voice Advocacy
- We asked people what we should do next and how we should do it



Learning Disability Strategy in Action



The Strategy was agreed in January 2024



An action plan was created



• First priority – Transport

The **strategy** promised to:

 Work with travel companies to make them more learning disability aware



 Work with partners to look at low-cost community transport for peopl with learning disabilities



Learning Disability Transport Project



 We talked to people with learning disabilities about travel experiences



We sent out a transport questionnaire



 We filmed people with learning disabilities talking about transport experiences

What We Found Out

Problems with public transport affect people's lives, especially vulnerable people or people with disabilities

Patience and understanding from people working in bus and train services

We require more support than you might think. Think how we feel

Many services have been cancelled, information about why has not been given in an easy read format

Timetables to be easier to read so I know where I'm going

What We Found Out

It is important to give vulnerable people who are using public transport priority to get onto a bus

A call out system for each stop would be good

Some people miss activities because times are not clear or buses are only running in some places.

Travel training would make me more confident

Buses coming on time would stop me being nervous

Learning Disability Transport Workshop



Transport Workshop was held on Tuesday 9th July



Over 70 people attended the workshop in person or on Zoom



 Talked the transport barriers people with learning disabilities face, like timetables not being in easy read

Learning Disability Transport Workshop



 Transport companies and community transport schemes talked about their services and support already available



 Everyone shared ideas on what a good journey would look like to you






In partnership with the Community Transport Association, we have created a Learning Disability Travel Charter.



We need transport that works for us

This means buses and trains that are easy to use





Timetables and signs should be clear and simple

We would understand them better if they were in easy read



Bus and train stations should have safe spaces

We need to feel safe when we travel





Staff should be well trained about learning disabilities

Travel would be easier if they know how to help us



We want to be treated with dignity and respect


This is very important to us





If service is poor, we need easy ways to complain
